DURING THE FOSTER PERIOD HRH WILL PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING:

1. Advice on the needs of the greyhound and continued support by regular contact with you.
2. All the necessary equipment required to take care of the greyhound. This includes collar, lead, muzzle, coat, bedding, food stand, bowls, etc.



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3. Parasite control and vaccinations if required, to keep up to date.
4. Veterinary costs for any illness or routine treatment only - see condition 3 below.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

By agreeing to foster I accept the following terms and conditions:

1. A collar and identity disc will be worn by the dog at all times (this is a legal requirement).
2. The greyhound will be kept in a sound and healthy condition during the foster period. HRH will be advised of any health concerns immediately, and every care taken to manage the hound's health according to the advice given by HRH
3. Any routine veterinary care, such as parasite treatment or vaccination, will be funded by HRH, at a veterinary practice agreed with HRH if necessary. Any treatment required for injuries or accidents occurring during the foster period is the responsibility of the foster carer named above. HRH will be informed immediately if any such treatment is required, so that it can be authorised by HRH as the owner of the hound.
4. PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE WILL ONLY BE PROVIDED IF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET:
 - a) the greyhound is muzzled when in a public place
 - b) the greyhound is on a lead when outside the house and any associated garden
 - c) the greyhound is under the control of an adult (18 years or over)
5. HRH reserves the right to visit the greyhound in the home environment at any time provided reasonable notice is given and terminate this foster agreement if any of the agreed conditions are not being met.
6. HRH reserve the right to bring the greyhound back into their care if they believe the welfare of the greyhound is compromised or is showing signs of severe distress.
